Relevant contextual information about your school and School Development Plan:

Annie Foote School is a K-6 school with approximately 500 students from the communities of Temple and Skyview. Our students come from multicultural backgrounds and 54% are English as Another Language Learners. Each of our classrooms has a SMARTBoard that both teachers and students use. All classrooms have at least one computer and iPad that remain in the classrooms. The students also have access to six technology carts that have a combination of laptops, Chromebooks and iPads. Our learning commons (library) is in the middle of the school with a growing fiction and non-fiction print collection. A Makerspace is in the learning commons where carts and bins are filled with a variety of materials for students to use their hands and minds to enhance learning.

Relevant evidence and data that informs your Digital Citizenship Plan:

- Division 1 students are just learning about accounts, passwords, login in and producing work in a digital environment.
- As our students are learning to be respectful citizens in person, they are also exploring the need for the same in the online world
- Students do require support in understanding the permanence of a digital footprint and the risk one takes when sharing private information.
