

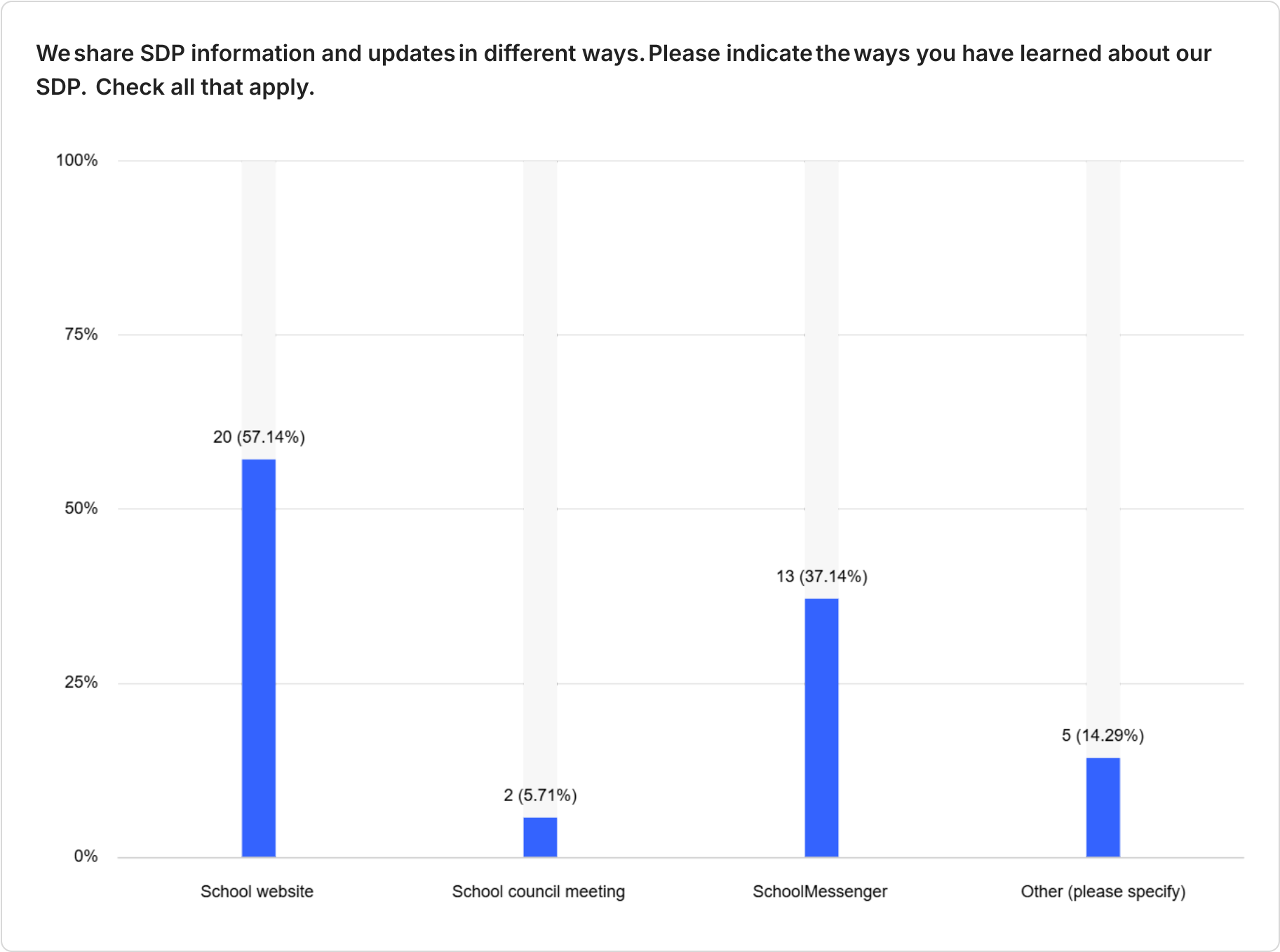

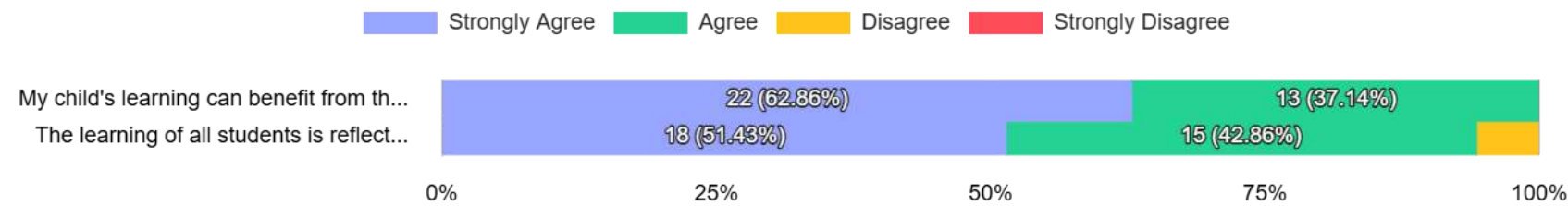

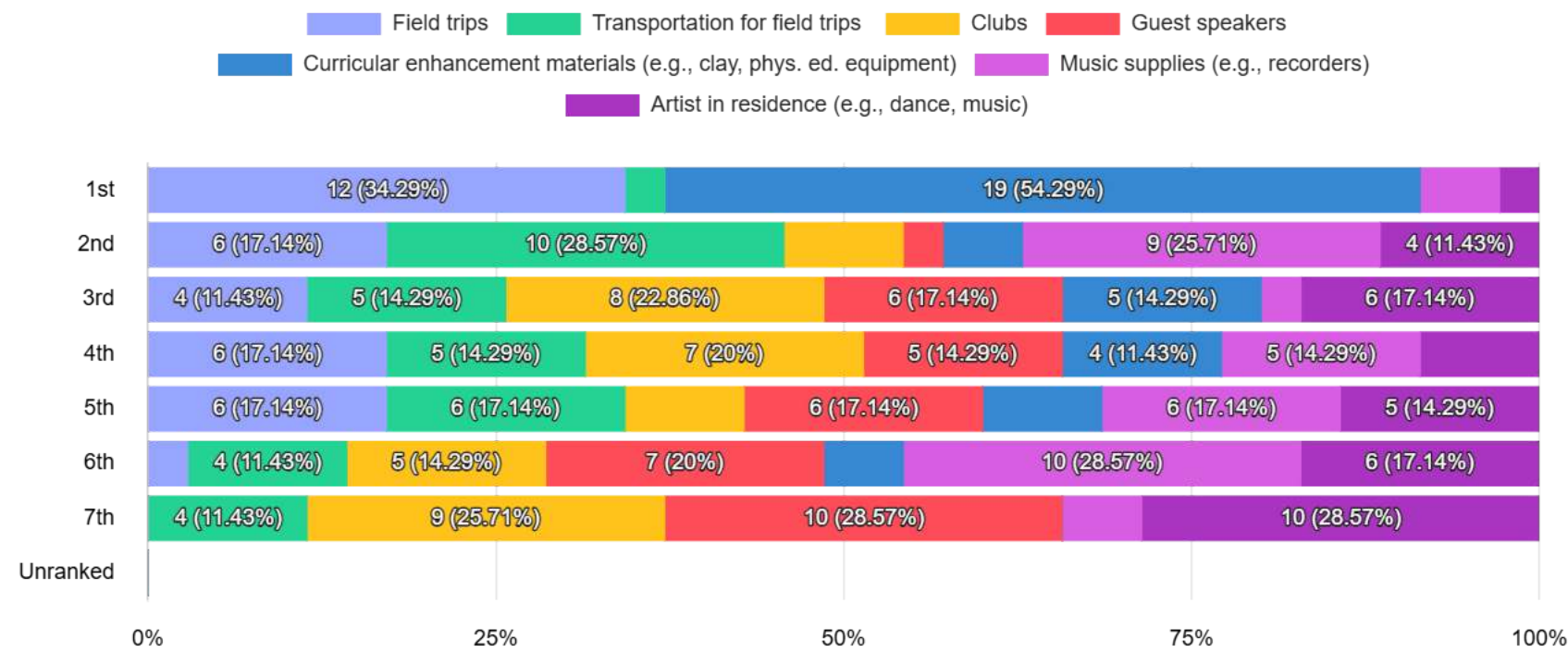
We appreciate the fact that SDP supports a culture of excellence and continuous learning. It is a valuable tool for guiding school improvement and enhancing student success.

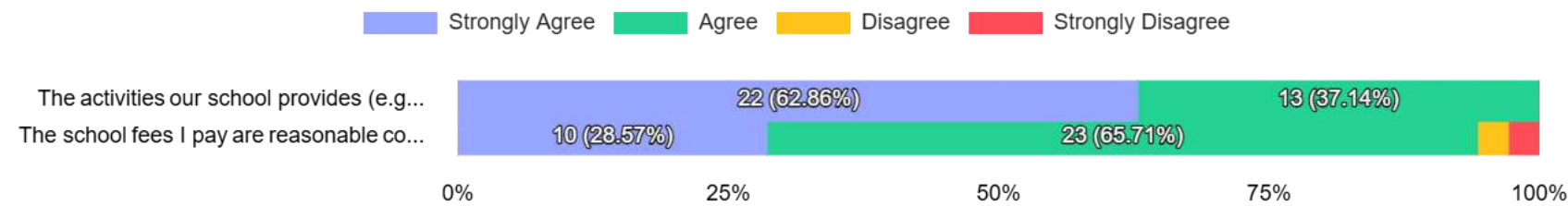
